

EDITORIAL GUIDELINES

The editors of the journal will be pleased to accept articles, notes and book reviews. These should be sent in Word format as well as in PDF to the following email address: publicacions@teologia-catalunya.cat.

The main language of the contributions is Catalan, but Castillian Spanish, English, French, German and Italian are also accepted. Documents should follow the style of the Facultat de Teologia de Catalunya, as set out in *Llibre d'estil per a la redacció d'escrits de teologia i de filosofia* (Barcelona 2008) and in an abbreviated form at www.teologia.catalunya.cat.

The maximum length for contributions is 50,000-60,000 characters for articles, and 35,000 for philological or bibliographical notes. Authors are asked to provide their name and forename, the name of their institution, postal address and email address.

Articles should be accompanied by an abstract of 10 lines in the original language and another of the same length in English (except for articles written in English, in which case the editors will translate the abstract into Catalan).

Up to 5 illustrations may be included. These should be sent in one of the following formats: TIFF, JPG, PNG or BMP. Mention should be made of the source and/or permission for their publication. Reference should be made in the text to such illustrations using brackets (e.g., Fig. 1, Table 1).

The originals will be considered by two assessors appointed by the editorial committee. Any recommendations they believe desirable will be sent to the author who should make the necessary alterations in order to bring the text into line with sound scholarly practice. In this process, both the author and the assessors will remain anonymous. After three months at the latest, the author will be informed if the contribution has been accepted by the editorial committee for publication.

First proofs will be sent to the author in PDF format for checking. Any comments should be written on paper and sent to the editors within a period of 15 days from receipt of the PDF document. If no reply has been received within that time, it will be assumed that the author wishes to make no modifications.

The *Revista Catalana de Teologia* will give to the author three copies of the issue in which the contribution appears, in addition to a PDF copy of the final version of the contribution.
